# Haselgrove 4DW1 Well Test

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Beach Energy advises the local community that flaring of the Haselgrove 4DW1 well located 7.5km south of Penola, will commence from mid-June, running for several hours to days at a time over a one to two-week period.

Regional Manager for the South East Jon Conti said flaring is a standard procedure in the industry and is performed under strict safety and environmental conditions.

“Flaring is done to recover final drilling fluids from the well and to determine the pressure, flow and composition of the natural gas from the well,” Mr Conti said.

“As always, the safety of our people, the community and the area in which we operate remains our number one priority – we continue to work closely with local authorities and keep them closely informed.”

The Haselgrove 4DW1 well was designed as a deviated well, using the existing Haselgrove 4 well drilled in mid-2019.

Following testing, it is expected that the well will be tied-in to the recently commissioned Katnook Gas Processing Facility.
